



COURSE OVERVIEW

Gain the skills to launch your career in the beauty industry as a Beautician with SHB30121 Certificate III in Beauty Services. This qualification is designed for either the beginner or those who have basic beauty and/or makeup skills. If you are wanting to learn more and commence working at a professional industry level this is the qualification for you.

You will develop a range of practical skills and valuable industry knowledge and learn a core set of skills:

- Provide waxing, lash and brow services
- Provide nail services, including manicures and pedicures with use of the electric file
- Apply tanning products
- Design and apply basic day & evening makeup looks
- Apply eyelash extensions
- Employ sales techniques and advise on products and services
- Conduct salon financial transactions in a salon environment
- Safe hygiene and work practices and infection control

This qualification provides a pathway to work as a beautician in a salon or home-based salon that performs beauty, makeup and nail services. This qualification can also be used as a stepping stone to higher beauty and make-up qualifications.

Successful completion of this course leads to exciting career opportunities in the beauty industry. Graduates from Certificate III in Beauty Services are able to gain employment as:

- Beautician
- Beauty retail cosmetic consultant
- Product specialist or sales advisor

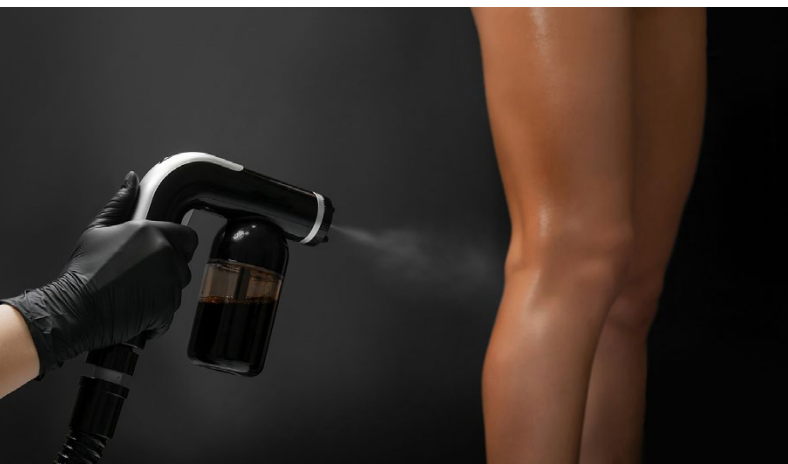
ADDITIONAL STUDY/TRAINING

Both streams include approximately 6 additional hours per week of prescribed reading, learner guides and workbook activities, knowledge questions and assignments (as applicable) that is to be completed off-campus.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The only formal entry requirement for this qualification is that students enrolling must be 15 years or older.

Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) Assessment: As a requirement of the student entry procedure, students may have to undertake a Language Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment. This is assessed on a case-by-case scenario.





STUDENT REQUIREMENTS & ADDITIONAL FEES

- WA Academy beauty uniform tunic to be worn with black professional pants and black enclosed shoes.
- Student will be required to supply a towelling body wrap and headband.
- General stationery and a padlock for use of the lockers.
- Students are to purchase a Make-up Kit from WA Academy which includes a brush set, make-up products, strip eyelashes and tools required to complete their qualification.
- Students are required to supply models for all practical assessments to demonstrate their technical skills.
- The Training Package stipulates that all practical assessments must be performed on a variety of models.
- Models are required to pay the model assessment fee charge as assessments must be performed on paying clients.
